## RESPONDING TO INCIDENTS, DISCLOSURES AND SUSPICIONS OF CHILD ABUSE

Keeping children safe in the community is important. If you see an incident, or become aware of a disclosure, complaint, allegation or suspicion of child abuse, follow the steps below:



A child reports, you observe, suspect or are informed of an incident of child abuse or neglect.



If a child is in immediate danger, risk or harm call the Police or Ambulance on **000**.

**OR**

Report to the relevant authorities and police as soon as possible on the details below.



The Police or Authorities will provide further advice on the next steps.
